This interdisciplinary documentary prompted by the covid-19 virus and the bi centenary of the birth of Florence Nightingale will combine newly released music by multi award winning composer Adam Johnson, photography and poetry written by children in isolation, as well as real-life interviews with medical personnel, intertwined with contemporary dance. We are looking for a filmmaker to document this process and the resulting performance.

We are looking for an outstanding (ideally aged 21-25) young filmmaker, if possible with North East connections, who can demonstrate a high level of commitment and enthusiasm for a collaborative project of this kind.

The resulting film will be screened on ESD's website, and shared online via other partners and social media channels, regional and nationally.

This is an exciting offer for a filmmaker in the early stages of their career to work with experienced and award winning artists, as well as providing a unique opportunity to be involved with the delivery of work during self-isolation.

Filming will begin in June 2020 and the online premiere / release will be on 31 July 2020.
